1. Venue

The Open Belgian Championships 2005 for the 420, 470 and Europe Class and a Cadet and Optimist Class Regatta will be organised by W.S.K.Lum. and R.Y.C.B.in Nieuwpoort, assisted by the respective Belgian Classes. The races will be sailed on the North Sea off Nieuwpoort, Belgium on September 10th and 11th 2005.

2. Schedule

12.30 Start 1st race of the day.

Sunday 11th September: 09.00 Race Office open.

10:00 Start 1st race of the day.

Any race not validly started by 15.30 on Sunday 11th September 2005, will be cancelled. Prize giving ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the last race.

3. Rules

This event will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, the regulations for Championships of the Royal Belgian Yaghting Federation (RBYF), Class Rules when applicable, except as any of these are changed in the Sailing Instructions at your disposition at the race office.

5. Entry fee

The entry fee is \in 30,00 payable at the race office.

6. Eligibility

The competitor's ISAF Eligibility applies (RRS Appendix 2 - ISAF Eligibility Code).

7. Measurement Certificates

Each yacht shall have a valid measurement certificate, the necessary measurement forms and a valid sailing license as required by its national authority.

8. Scoring system

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A, will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst score discarded if 4 or more races have been completed.

9. Jury

Direct judging for RRS 42 may be applied.

10. Sailing instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

11. Liability and Insurance

Participants compete at their own risk and responsibility. The organising Committee, the Race officer, the Jury, or any person directly or indirectly involved in the organisation, cannot be held responsible for any personal or material damage (including, but not limited to death, injury, consequential losses) sustained prior to, during or after the races.

A certificate of valid third-party liability insurance, with a minimum cover of 120,000 Euro per event, shall be shown at registration (or equivalent value in the currency of the country of registration of the boat). It shall be the sole responsibility of each competitor to have such insurance and to provide the written proof thereof at registration, without which entry will be refused.

12. Trophies and Prizes

Overall prizes will be awarded to the first three competitors finishing the race Other prizes may be awarded.

13. Social

A competitors diner will be organised on Saturday 12^{th} September 2004 Mussels or steack, french fries and sauce followed by a sweet for the democratic price of $\in 15,00$
