2019 Technical Committee Report

This report covers the period between August 2018 and July 2019

CLASS RULES

There are no new class rule change proposals this year.

BUILDERS & PROTOTYPES

There were no new builders added or new prototypes measured during the period covered by this report.

INTERNATIONAL MEASURERS

There are no changes to the IM team and no plans for increasing the number of 420 IMs.

EVENT MEASUREMENT SYSTEM

For 2020 there will be an experimental simplification in the event measurement system, following the steps of the 470 Class, where the fleet will be divided in a so called 'full' measurement and a 'simple' measurement category, based on national rankings or national regatta results, to save time and effort. This will be finalized after the analysis of the measurement data from the 2019 Worlds and Junior Europeans. The equipment will still need to be marked for each event, but rigs and foils may be excluded from actual inspection for the 'simple' measurement option. Depending on the results of the measurement data analysis from 2020, the hull weighing may be also excluded if the data on the certificates is considered reliable.
