The "IX ANDALUSIAN OLYMPIC WEEK", XIV Carnival Trophy, for the following Olympic Classes: 49er - 49er FX - Laser St- 470 m&w - Laser Radial w - RS:X m&w - Finn with the following invited Classes: Laser Radial men - Laser 4.7 - RS:X 8.5 Youth and 420, will be held in the Bay of Cadiz, Puerto Sherry (Puerto Santa Maria) from 26th to 2nd of March 2014. both inclusive. This Event is organised by the Andalusian Sailing Federation and the Royal Spanish Sailing Federation with the sponsorship of the "Consejeria de Cultura y Deportes de la Junta de Andaluca", the "Instituto para el Fomento del Deporte de la Excma. Diputaci⊡n Provincial de C⊡diz" and the cooperation of Marina Puerto Santa Mar⊡a S.L. This Event is considered a Grade 3 by the ISAF for the Olympic Classes

1 RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, RRS
- 1.2 The Prescriptions of the Royal Spanish Sailing Federation will not apply.
- Appendix P (RRS) will be applied. (Except for the RS:X Class) 1.3
- 1.4 Personal buoyancy may be required for the coaches and support personnel at all times while afloat.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, the English text will prevail.

2 ELIGIBILITY, CLASSES.

- The "IX SEMANA OL MPICA ANDALUZA" XIV Carnival Trophy, is open to all boats of the 2.1 Laser St, Laser Radial m/w, Laser 4.7, 470m/w, 49er, 49er FX, Finn, 420 and RS:X m/w & 8.5 Youth Classes.
- 2.2 RS:X Youth sailors shall be under the age of 19 years on 31 December 2014.
- 2.3 Olympic gender requirements will apply for each Olympic event

 - Evidence of valid third party insurance with a minimum covert of €300,000
 - · Identity Card or Passport.
 - · Proof of Entry fee payment.

- 5.2 12 races (16 for 49er, 49er FX) are scheduled for each event. 2 races are required to be completed to consitute a series.
- 5.3 The last possible warning signal on Sunday 2nd is 16:00 h.

6 RACING FORMAT

- 6.1 The courses will be as similar as possible to those of the Olympic Regatta and will be decided on guidelines from the ISAF.
- All the Classes shall sail as one fleet, except the Classes with more that 70 entries 6.2 whom will sail a qualifying series and a final series.

7 MEASUREMENTS

7.1 Boats may be measured in any moment during racing for compliance with the class.

8 RESULTS AND PRIZES

- 8.1 Differents overall results will be established for the Classes properly constituted.
- 8.2 The trophies list will be published on the official notice board at the beginning of the Event.

9 DOPING CONTROL

9.1 Competitors are reminded of the ISAF rules and regulations concerning the use of banned methods and substances, which are contained in ISAF Anti-Doping Code. Drug testing may take place during this event.

10 INSURANCE

10.1 Each participating boat and coach boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of € 300,000 euros per event or the equivalent.

11 DISCLAMER OF LIABILITY
