RULES

The Regatta will be governed by:

- 1. The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), including the Federation's prescriptions and rules, together with the Class Rules for the 420 series and the UNIQUA-France sports rules 2017-2018.
- 2. The national prescriptions apply to competitors from other counties as specified in Appendix « Prescriptions » if required,
- 3. The French text will prevail over this translation.

ADVERTISING

4. Applying world sailing Rule 20 (Advertising Code), as modified by the advertising rule of the French Federation, the boats may have to accept the ads chosen and furnished by the Organising Committee.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

5. The Regatta is open to all the boats of the 420 Class, the team of which will have to present for registration:

For applicants (skippers and crews) residing in France:

- a valid FFVoile licence, stamped by a medical doctor, otherwise a medical certificate of non-exclusion for sailing practice, dated less than a year, and for minors, a parent's authorization,
- if applicable, the advertising authorisation,
- the boat Measurement Certificate.

For applicants (skippers and crews) not licensed in France:

- the proof of registration to a National Authority which is member of ISAF.
- 6. The crews of the boats meeting requirements have to fill out the registration form and send it and the registration fee to the CVMartigues.
- 7. Late registrations will be accepted, but the fee is increased, except for teams from other countries.

8. Normal fee: €110.until 6 april 2018 Late fee: €130. From to 7 april 2018

Awards Ceremony as soon as possible after the last race.

MEASUREMENTS

12. Boats shall comply with 420 Class Rules and may be inspected for compliance prior to or during racing. The conformity certificates or Measurement Forms will be presented at control, as well as advertising certificates for French boats. Sails not previously certified will not be accepted. Control will occur before and during races.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

13. Sailing Instructions and Appendices will be available on web site and during registration confirmation on April 15 and 16. http://www.cvmartigues.net

VENUE

14. The regatta will take place on the lake Etang de Berre

COURSES

15. The courses shall be prescribed in the Sailing Instructions and may include windward-leeward, triangle and trapezoid course types.

If the number of participants is less or equal to 60, there will be only one group.

If the number of participants is over 60, there will be several groups with qualification and final races according to Sailing Instructions.

PENALTY SYSTEM

16. Rules 44.1 and 44.2 will apply.

17. Appendix P will apply. RCV P2.3 will not apply and RCV P2.2 will apply for each breach after the first.

18. Rule 42 of RCV (2013-2016) apply such as amended by 420 Class Rule C1.2.

19. The Low Point System of Appendix A of RCV will apply.

20. Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 20.1. When fewer than 5 races have been completed in a series, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.
- 20.2. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 21. The maximum numbers of races is 12.

SUPPORT BOATS

22. Support boats have to be registered at Club Secretary's Office.

RADIO COMMUNICATION

23. Except on emergency, whilst on the water, a boat shall not carry-on radio emission or reception which can't be received by all the boats.

This restriction applies to cell phones.

DISCLAIMER

24. All competitors participating to the races do it at their own risk. The decision to participate into a race, or keep racing, is done under their own responsibility. The organisation structure will not be liable for any equipment damage, personal injury or death, during the event, as well as before, during and after the races.

INSSURANCE

Each participating boat from another country not licensed to the French Federation FFVoile shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1 500 000 (one and half million Euros).
