NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Sailing Instructions means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The class rules of the 470 and 420 classes respectively will apply.
- **1.4** Appendix T will apply
- **1.5** Appendix P may apply.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]
- **2.2** Boats shall not display advertising that conflicts with the regatta sponsors or the Organising authority

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY





- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the 420 and 470 class(es) that comply with the class rules and whose owner(s) are current financial members of their respective Class Associations.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to **Takapuna Boating Club no later than 1700 Hours,** 02 February 2018. Send entries and payment to:

3.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by their national authority. Proof of membership of an affiliated club is to be submitted with entry.

6.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate if asked.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at each class registration and may be published on the contest web site prior to this.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

- a) Windward Leeward [WL] 470 class only on Friday.
- b) Trapezoid with signal boat for start and finish for all classes Saturday and Sunday.
- c) Refer Appendix A for course diagrams.



10 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the 420 class only, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

11.1 Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2

- a) When fewer than 6(six) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When 6 (six) to 11(eleven) races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score.
- c) When 12 (twelve) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst 2 scores.

12 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park [DP]

13 Yacht Chartering

Both 420 and 470 yachts will be available for charter. First come, first serve basis.

470:

Used Mackay(s) hull and foils, Superspa rig, beach trailer and running rigging.
Sails not provided.

420:

Used Zeigelmeyer(s) hull and foils, Superspa rig, beach trailer and running rigging.
Sails not provided.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION



Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

15 PRIZES

NZ 470 [Residential] National Championship Cup. NZ 470 [Residential] Ladies Championship Cup. NZ 470 [Residential] Youth (Under 23) Cup.

North Island 420 Championship Cup.

In addition, miscellaneous (Take home trophies, medals, Sponsor products) 1^{st} / 2^{nd} / 3^{rd} place prizes for both i420 and 470 classes will be associated.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of NZD\$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
