# 420 /470 SUMMER NATIONAL EVENT July 12<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>, 2008 Notice of Race

# 1. Organisation:

The 2008 summer French national event both for 470 Class and 420 Class will be organised in Ile Tudy (south of Brittany) on July 12th to 17th by **Centre Nautique de l'Ile-Tudy**, affililiated to the French Sailing Federation - FFVoile, in conjonction with the French 420 Class - UNIQUA-France - and the French 470 Class – AS 470 France.

### 2. Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by:
  - the « rules » as defined in the ISAF RRS
  - the prescription of FFVoile shall apply
  - the current Class Rules for 420 class and 470 class
  - this Notice of Race
  - the sailing instructions and its appendices
- 2.2 Advertising will be governed by:
  - the event is classified category C in accordance to the ISAF Regulation 20advertising code
  - rule 79 of RRS
  - 420 and 470 class rules
  - the prescription of FFvoile for French competitors

The official language of the event is French. The official documents of the event are the French versions.

# 3 Registrations:

The competitors shall send a pre-registration form by post mail, with the registration fees, to:

Registration fees: until 24<sup>th</sup> of June 2008: 96 €Euro, (including event diner for crews)

after 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2008: 140 €Euro

For French crews, a pre-registration without including fees payment will not be valid. For crews coming from other countries the fees will be fixed to 96 €Euro even if they send pre-registration in time by e-mail of fax.

# 4 Final registrations:

4.1 The measurement control and the registration are scheduled on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> of July, from 2PM to 7PM, and on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> of July from 9AM to 6PM.

# 4.2 Eligibility / Entry

Each competitor shall comply with its National Authority rules.

For registration validation each competitor **shall provide**:

- sailing license 2008 with a medical authorization to for sailing in competition
- national Class registration
- advertising license, if required (for French competitor only)
- measurement certificate or measurement form of the boat
- authorization to participate to the event, if less than 18-years old, delivered by parent or coach (see registration form).

The competitors, coaches and accompanying people coming from other countries shall produced on registration, an evidence third party insurance, with a minimum of 500.000 EUROS or the equivalent in other currencies, which covers any damage or accident caused at any time of the event.

### 4.3 Measurement control:

Each boat shall comply with the current Class Rules. The Measurement Form or the Measurement Certificate shall be produced at the measurement control desk. The 420 and the 470 sails shall be certified according to the class rules. Measurement Control could be organized at any time during the event both on the waters and on the boats park.

### 4.4 Sailing instructions:

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the race office after the measurement control and after the registration have been completed, until the registration closure deadline.

### 4.5 Responsibility:

In any case the organizing committee will have responsibility of loose, damage or accident which could be taken place during the event.

# 6. Identification

According to the ISAF RRS Appendix G « identification », boat without sail number or with a sail number different as the sail number used for registration will be considered as DNS.

#### 7. Event Format

For the « 420 », if less than 80 entries, boats will compete in one separated fleet. If 80 entries or more, boats will compete in two separated fleets with a qualifying series phase and a final series phase (Gold and Silver fleets). The event format will be in accordance with the current « Règlement Sportif » edited by the French 420 Class, and will be detailed in Sailing Instructions.

For the « 470 », if less than about 50 entries, boats will compete in one separated fleet. If more than about 50 entries, boats will compete in two separated fleets with a qualifying series phase and a final series phase (Gold and Silver fleets). Decision of using or not separated fleets will be made by the race committee officer.

### 7.1 Course:

The format of the course will be a trapezium, a triangle or a up/down wind race.

### 7.2 Scoring:

The maximum number of races shall be 12.

Four (4) races shall require for the event validation.

The low point scoring system of ISAF Regulation Appendix A4.1 shall apply.

Score will be calculated including all the valid races, with one discard if a minimum of 4 races are validated, and with two discards if a minimum of 8 races are validated.

### 8 Penalties:

8.1: The ISAF Regulation 44.2 will be applied

8.2: The ISAF Regulation 42 will be applied in accordance with the derogation of International 420 Class Regulation C1.2 and in accordance with the corresponding 470 class rule C1.1.

# 9 Safety regulations:

Application of class rules.

### 10 Specific rules for the course area:

Competitors shall be paid a special attention to the sailing instructions appendices on rules governing the ship waiting area.

### 12 Prices:

At least the first 3 crews of the event final ranking list, of each class and for both men and ladies, will received a price.

### 13 Authorization to use competitor's names and photos/videos:

Registration to the event imposes automatically transfer, to the event organization and its partners, of rights to use names, photos and videos of competitors recorded during the event, without compensation to the competitor.
